



TRAUMA NURSING CORE COURSE (TNCC) FEBRUARY 10-11, 2012

The TNCC Provider Course is a two-day program designed to provide core-level knowledge and psychomotor skills necessary to care for trauma patients in emergency situations. This is a nationally recognized program made available to you through the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA) and highly recommended for nurses who care for patients with traumatic injuries.

This would include:

- Nurses practicing in an emergency department setting
- Critical care nurses
- Nurses caring for trauma patients in a medical-surgical or out-patient setting
- OR nurses who may care for patients in the surgical setting
- Nurses on general trauma units
- Nurses participating in the transport of critically ill patients with traumatic injury

PREREQUISITES

Provider Course: TNCC may be attended by registered nurses.

COURSE LOCATION

This year's course location will be at Doctor's Regional campus. Exact room information will be communicated to you.

REGISTRATION

Courses are limited to 24 participants. Registration for CCMC employees can be accomplished through HealthStream. Non-hospital nurses may contact Ann Woodworth at: 361-215-4630 to arrange registration. Courses fill up quickly, so register asap! You must coordinate your time off the unit with your manager/director.

CANCELLATIONS

Once you have registered, you may not opt out. If a registered participant is unable to attend, it is their responsibility to find a replacement, and give them any literature received. Substitutions are welcome. But remember, the new registrant will need time to review the literature to support successful completion of the course. A no-show will incur a \$275 charge to your department. For non-hospital nurses, cost is \$275 per person and includes the book.

LITERATURE

Books will be distributed directly to you, or your manager/director. **Due to the intensive nature of the course, participants are strongly urged to read their manual thoroughly prior to the course. Day Two includes a written examination.**
